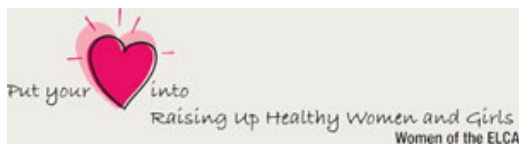
What to expect: Bible study, worship, singing, spiritual friendships, journaling, sharing the Gospel, service to others, inspirational entertainment
